- I write with reference to your enquiry regarding a drainage issue on Moor Lane, Dale Abbey and apologise for the time taken to reply. Our senior technician advises that following investigations with the jetting unit on 17 February, 2021 all Derbyshire County Council highway drainage assets were found to be clear to the outfall into the open ditch. The ditch and converted section at the vehicle entrance to an adjacent property was found to be restricted/full. As such, this is a private maintenance concern for the responsible riparian landowner and therefore, a letter will be sent to the landowner asking them to attend to the maintenance of the ditch.
